Investment Objective: The investment objective of the FI Institutional Global Sustainable Equity Impact Fund (the "Fund") is to outperform the Benchmark over a full market cycle while positively contributing to a future of sustainable and inclusive growth by investing in only assets (other than cash, cash equivalents and money market instruments) that are considered to be sustainable investments ("Sustainable Investments") under SFDR. There is no guarantee the investment objective will be achieved.

Investment Policy: The Fund invests primarily in equities and equity-related securities of, or linked to, issuers included in the country indices represented within the Benchmark, but may invest up to 20% of its total assets in equities and equity-related securities of, or linked to, issuers located in countries not represented within the Benchmark and may invest up to 10% of its total assets in unlisted equities. The Investment Manager considers Environmental, Social and Governance ("ESG") factors, including ESG events or conditions that, if they occur, could cause a negative material impact on the value of an investment ("Sustainability Risk"), throughout the investment and portfolio construction process. The Fund is actively managed by the Investment Manager, meaning that investment decisions are made on a fully discretionary basis. Accordingly, the portfolio holdings may significantly deviate from the Benchmark. Prior to investing in the Fund, you should take into account all characteristics and objectives of the Fund as described in the Fund's prospectus and supplement. 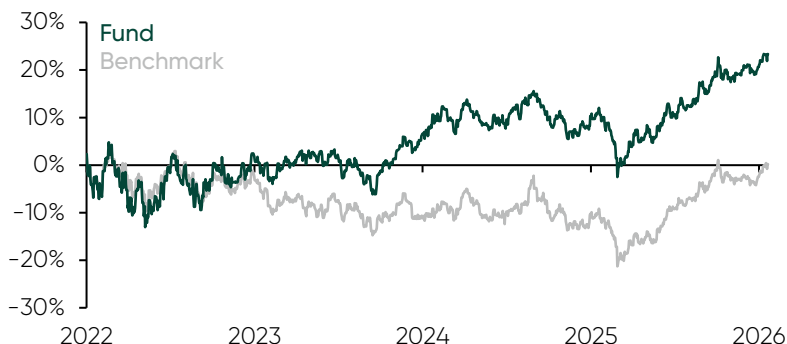

Cumulative Performance Since Inception



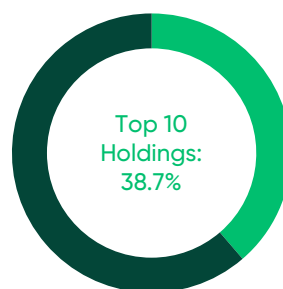

Currency Risk: The base currency of the Fund is USD. The non-USD share classes may be affected unfavourably by fluctuations in currency rates.

Liquidity Risk: Some of the Fund's investments may be difficult to buy or sell. This might affect the price at which the investments can be sold, which would affect the Fund's value.

Counterparty Risk: There is a risk that counterparties to some of the Fund's investments may not perform their obligations and that transactions may not settle.

Emerging Markets Risk: The Fund invests in the emerging markets equities market, which carries a higher than average investment risk and the Fund may have problems or delays in getting its investments back when required.

Stock Connect Risk: The Fund may trade through the Shanghai and Shenzhen Stock Connect programmes, which introduces regulatory risks that may prevent timely purchases and/or sales of securities and other risks unique to the stock connect programme.

ESG Risk: The Fund may be subject to regulatory uncertainty and additional costs in implementing ESG regulations and is reliant on ESG data which may not always be accurate or complete. The Fund might underperform relative to comparable funds that do not incorporate ESG factors or pursue a sustainable investment objective.

As further described in the Fund's KIID, this Fund has a risk classification score of 5 due to its exposure to equity markets, which means the Fund may experience significant volatility. The Fund is a sub-fund of Fisher Investments Institutional Funds plc (the "Company"), an investment company with variable capital incorporated on 24 March 2011 and authorised in Ireland by the Central Bank of Ireland (the "Central Bank") as an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities pursuant to the European Communities (Undertakings for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities) Regulations, 2011 as amended. The Company's authorisation does not constitute a warranty by the Central Bank as to the performance of the Company and the Central Bank is not liable for the performance or default of the Company.
2. Fisher Investments was established as a sole proprietorship in 1979 and succeeded its investment adviser registration to a limited liability in 2005. "Years" is calculated using the date on which Fisher Investments was established as a sole proprietorship: 1979.

US Dollar 2 Class Shares may be offered to the retail sector and may be purchased by individual or institutional investors or distributors, Paying agents, brokers or other financial intermediaries. The investment management fee for the F Class shares (unhedged) is 0.0%. F Class Shares are available to the initial investor in the Fund. The investment management fee for UK DC Class Shares (unhedged) Shares is 0.75%. UK DC Class Shares are available only to certain categories of investors as determined by the Directors in their absolute discretion.
8. The Ongoing Charges is the overall cost shown as a percentage of the value of the assets of the Fund. It is made up of the Management Fee and other costs of running the Fund. It does not include any initial charges or the transaction costs involved in buying and selling investments for the Fund.
