What is this product?

Type

Share of a sub-fund part of an umbrella fund in corporate form.

Term

This product does not have a maturity date, the competent body of the PRIIP (as identified in the offering documentation) is entitled to terminate the product. The amount you would receive in the event of such termination might be lower than the amount you invested.

Objectives

Investment objective The Fund is a feeder fund of JP Morgan Investment Funds – Global Income Conservative Fund incorporated in the Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg (the "Master Fund"). The Fund seeks to provide regular income by permanently investing at least 85% of its net assets in class X of the Master Fund.

Investment policy The Master Fund invests primarily in a conservatively constructed portfolio of income generating securities, globally, and through the use of derivatives

The Master Fund promotes environmental and social characteristics pursuant to Article 8 of Regulation 2019/2088 ("SFDR").

The Master Fund will seek to achieve its investment objective through a multi-asset approach with a focus on risk-adjusted income and a flexible implementation at asset class and regional level. The Master Fund may vary its allocation response to market conditions, however will aim to have a higher allocation to debt securities than to other asset classes.

The Master Fund primarily invests in debt securities including Mortgage-Backed Security / Asset-Backed Security, equities and Real Estate Investment Trusts (REITs) from issuers anywhere in the world, including emerging markets.

The Master Fund may invest in below investment grade and unrated securities.

The Master Fund may invest in China A-Shares via the China-Hong Kong Stock Connect Programmes, and in convertible securities and currencies.

The Master Fund invests at least 51% of its net assets in issuers with positive environmental and/or social characteristics that follow good governance practices as measured through its Investment Manager's proprietary ESG scoring methodology and/or third party data.

The Investment Manager of the Master Fund evaluates and applies values and norms based screening to implement exclusions. To support this screening, on all issuers it relies on third party provider(s) who identify an issuer's participation in or the revenue which they derive from activities that are inconsistent with the values and norms based screens. The list of screens applied that may result in exclusions can be found on the website

of the Master Fund's Investment Manager: www.jpmorganassetmanagement.lu.

The Master Fund may invest up to 3% of its net assets in contingent convertible bonds.

The Fund may hold up to 15% of its net assets in ancillary liquid assets such as cash and cash equivalents, including time deposits and Money Market Instruments having an initial or residual maturity of less than 12 months or with an interest adapted at least annually according to the market conditions.

The Master Fund uses the 55% Bloomberg Barclays Global Aggregate Index (Total Return Gross) Hedged to EUR + 30% Bloomberg Barclays US Corporate High Yield 2% Issuer Capped Index (Total Return Gross) Hedged to EUR + 15% MSCI World Index (Total Return Net) Hedged to EUR benchmark as point of reference against which its performance is measured.

The performance of the Fund shall be close to the performance of the Master Fund less Fund fees.

Benchmark The Fund has no reference benchmark.

Redemption policy The Fund is open-ended. You may redeem shares of the Fund on any Business Day on which the Master Fund is valued and open to redemptions.

Distribution policy The Share Class makes no dividend payment. Earned income is retained and reinvested.

Derivatives policy The Master Fund may use financial instruments and derivatives for hedging purposes, for efficient portfolio management purposes and for investment purposes.

Intended retail investor

The Fund expects that a typical investor in the Sub-fund will be a medium term investor who knows and accepts the risks associated with this type of investment. It is designed to form part of a portfolio of investments.



What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risks



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 4 Years.

The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less.

Performance scenarios

What happens if Generali Investments Luxembourg S.A. is unable to pay out?
